

Trailer Use Guidelines for Troop 537

- Trailer does NOT have brakes, but relies on the towing vehicle for braking.
- Always use a spotter when backing the trailer.
- Load planning info: Empty weight of trailer = 1100 lbs / GAWR (max weight of loaded trailer, both contents and trailer) not to exceed 2990 lbs.
- Trailer is only to be used for BSA Troop 537 related activities
- Please promptly notify the Troop Quartermaster, Tom Satterly, if there is a mechanical problem that requires attention, especially if it affects the safety or drivability of the trailer.
- The trailer is to be stored EMPTY and parked at Butterfly Dreams Farm at the designated location. The trailer shall be locked when not in use to prevent unauthorized use, entry, or accidental entrapment of children or others. A set of combination padlocks for the two doors are provided. The trailer tongue coupler shall be locked to prevent unauthorized towing or theft.
- During towing, insurance coverage is provided by the insurance policy of the towing vehicle. Suggest that owners of vehicles towing the trailer ensure their automobile liability insurance coverage is adequate.
- The entrance to Butterfly Dreams Farm is controlled by an automatic gate opener. To open the gate, whether entering or departing, simply press the button at the post on the driver's side of the road. The gate will close automatically once the vehicle passes through.
- Please note that Butterfly Dreams Farm is home to both a private residence and a business. When accessing the property, please respect the privacy of the residents and any business operations (horse riding).
